### SALT DOUGH CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS

Let's celebrate Christmas with a little homemade cheer

## STEP ONE CREATE SALT DOUGH FROM OUR SALT DOUGH RECIPE AT END

#### STEP TWO

Preheat oven to 300 degrees

#### STEP THREE

Place parchment paper down, put dough on parchment, place another piece of parchment on top, roll doll out until it is about 1/8 in thick.

#### STEP FOUR

Using cookie cutters, cut dough into shapes. Use a straw to poke a hole where you want ribbon to go through for hanging.

Add any other decorative impressions you would like.

#### STEP FIVE

Bake at 300, until hard



#### STEP SIX

After it comes out of oven let it cool completely.

#### STEP SEVEN

You can leave ornament as is, add a ribbon and hang OR you can paint it.
You can choose to leave the base the dough color OR you can mist it with white spray paint for a whte base


Make sure to let applique dry between every coat from here on out!

#### STEP EIGHT

Use acrylic or puffy paint to paint ornament. If you want to use glitter apply with modge podge or school glue

#### <u>Finally</u>

Protect with a coat of modge podge or poly spray, add a ribbon and you are done!



# TOUGE - TOUGH

Ingredients:
2 cups Flour
1 cup salt
1 cup water
Yields: 4 cups

Mix flour and salt together in a bowl.
Slowly mix water, a few tablespoons
at a time, into flour mixture until
dough is smooth and easy to handle.
Knead dough for 10 minutes and let
rest for 20 minutes.
