SALT DOUGH CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS

Let's celebrate Christmas with a little homemade cheer

STEP ONE

CREATE SALT
DOUGH FROM OUR
SALT DOUGH
RECIPE AT END

STEP FOUR

Using cookie cutters, cut dough into shapes. Use a straw to poke a hole where you want ribbon to go through for hanging.

Add any other decorative impressions you would like.

STEP TWO

Preheat oven to 300 degrees

STEP THREE

Place parchment paper down, put dough on parchment, place another piece of parchment on top, roll out until it is about 1/8 in thick.

STEP FIVE

Bake at 300, until hard



STEP SIX

After it comes out of oven let it cool completely.

STEP SEVEN

You can leave ornament as is, add a ribbon and hang OR you can paint it. You can choose to leave the base the dough color OR you can mist it with white spray paint for a white base

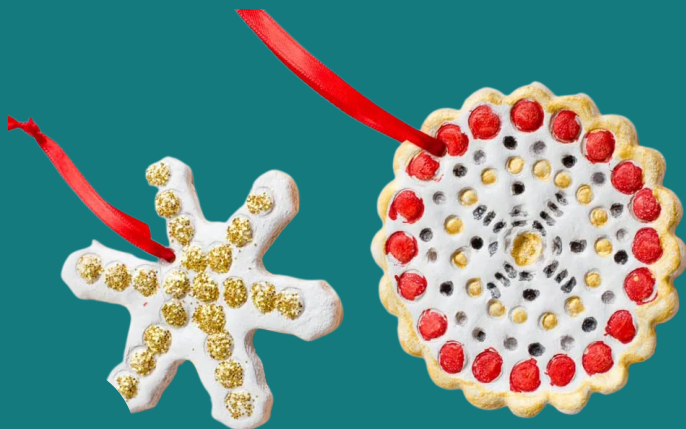
Make sure to let applique dry between every coat from here on out!

STEP EIGHT

Use acrylic or puffy paint to paint ornament. If you want to use glitter apply with modge podge or school glue

Finally

Protect with a coat of modge podge or poly spray, add a ribbon and you are done!



SALT DOUGH

RECIPE

Ingredients:

2 cups Flour

1 cup salt

1 cup water

Yields: 4 cups

**Mix flour and salt together in a bowl.
Slowly mix water, a few tablespoons
at a time, into flour mixture until
dough is smooth and easy to handle.
Knead dough for 10 minutes and let
rest for 20 minutes.**
